# Wilton Parks and Recreation Commission April 9, 2014

#### **Minutes**

### Parks and Grounds Update

- The staff has prepared all town fields for the spring sport season
- Chairmen Ketley commented on the exceptional efforts made by the staff to ready the baseball fields for play following the very difficult winter. Chairmen Ketley will be sending a thank you note to the staff in recognition of their efforts
- Pickleball has started at Comstock on Tuesdays and Thursdays
- Registration for summer programs is on hold until the state provides clarification on the ability to offer the program to 2 year olds

## **Comstock Renovation – Letter of Support**

The Commission drafted a letter to the public in support of the Comstock Renovation project. All Commissioners were in agreement on the need to renovate Comstock. Discussion took place on the Commission's ability to comment on the cost of the project.
