Minutes

No changes to the minutes of the October meeting were made.

Parks and Grounds Report

- Steve Pierce reported that the seasonal staff had concluded their allotted time working in the department. Efforts are being made with HR to explore the possible extension of employment of seasonal workers.
- Steve reported that progress is being made on the Parks and Recreation budget for FY2016. The budget will include an architectural fee for renovation plans at Merwin Meadows.
- Steve reported that discussions are ongoing regarding the needed repair of the walkway from Middlebrook School to Comstock including which town department should be responsible for the repair.

Recreation Report

- Rec basketball is underway with strong participation levels at the High School age group.
- Discussion occurred regarding the lighting of the high school track for recreational use. Kevin O'Brien made a motion to approve limited lighting at the track from 5:00pm-9:00pm, Monday through Friday, pending the ability to fit the expense in the budget. The motion was seconded by Bryan Dedrick. The motion passed 4-0.

Comstock

The Comstock renovation project is out for bid. Bids are due December 4, work will start March 30 and phase I is scheduled to be completed by September 18.

Public Comment

At the conclusion of the meeting, Commissioner Dedrick stated that his term was ending in December and that while it had been a pleasure to serve, he would not be continuing into a new term on the commission. Commissioner Ketley thanked Commissioner Dedrick for his service and said he would be missed.
