The inclement weather has resulted in Parks and Grounds being behind schedule. They will catch up but timing will be contingent on how quickly the snow melts and the fields dry out.

Recreation

Steve reported that the basketball program was wrapping up a successful season and that the brochure has been sent out for spring programming.

Comstock Building Committee

Commissioner Ketley updated the commission on the Building Committee progress. He reported that the next public meting will be on March 17, 2014.
