## April 18, 2016

Chairman Judy Zucker opened the meeting at 3:06 p.m.

The minutes of March 28, 2016 were approved as distributed.

Bill Brautigam explained that the new wall plaque would probably not be ready in time for the Comstock Open House on May 18. Steve Pierce, in behalf of the May Open House subcommittee, summarized the main plans, including public and individual invitations, building tours, program demonstrations and brief presentations at 1 p.m.

Steve Giametta in his construction update reviewed the schedule for remaining work and reported that the closeout process was 79% overall complete as of April 18.

Ty Tregellas presented Quisenberry Arcari's Addendum #8 requesting an additional fee of \$1,320.00 for additional design work relating to the second means of access along the northside of the building terminating at the basketball courts. Upon motion by Bill Brautigam, seconded by Dave Hapke, the committee unanimously approved the Addendum #8 request.

Steve Giametta presented the following 17 change orders for consideration, noting that all 17 included a "zero dollar final change order" which indicated that the final contract value had been verified and no further change orders would be issued:
