Chief Paul Milositz-Emergency Management Director, Town of Wilton

Chief Milositz has over 33 years of experience in the fire protection career field. Born in Allentown, PA, he was raised in Stratford and joined the U.S. Air Force shortly after graduating high school. Initially trained as an Air Force Medic the Chief was crossed trained into the fire protection career field early in his military career.
