

WILTON EDC MEETING MINUTES

November 18, 2015

In attendance: Chairman Peter W. Gaboriault, Lee Wilson, John Wilson, Dave Clune

Meeting was called to order at 7:20 pm.

Dave Clune, having been elected to the Board of Selectmen, stated that he would be submitting his resignation to the EDC. He will send to the BOS with a copy to Peter.

The status of Keith Rodgerson, who was elected to the Planning and Zoning Commission, was discussed. The commission was in agreement that he should resign from the EDC, but that ultimately it was up to the BOS to decide how to proceed.

There was agreement that the Fall Forum had gone very well. It is planned that a video will be posted on the website.

Cannondale was discussed. Peter Gaboriault brought up the idea of seeking grant money for Cannondale as Ridgefield did for Branchville. He pointed out that this was something tangible that the EDC could accomplish. After discussion, it was agreed that the Commission needs guidance from the BOS before proceeding. That an overall strategy needs to be agreed upon before any action can be taken.

Lee Wilson reported that he had been approached by a tenant looking to build a new building of approximately 25,000 square feet. Potential locations were discussed.

Lee also reported that Kimco, the owner of the Stop & Shop Center was looking to make a donation to improve Wilton Center. It was agreed that the best spot would be Schenck's Island.
